Beginning of the meeting:

The Technical Commission begins the session at 9 am in Room 1 of the CCCB in order to select the 10 finalist projects of the second call of the Cultural Innovation International Prize, according to the individual evaluations of the 165 projects admitted to the prize, out of a total of 218 projects submitted.

In light of the evaluations conducted beforehand, the Technical Commission shortlisted the 10 projects listed below and asked their representatives to submit documentation proving their legal personality within 10 working days, according to rule 10 of the call.

All applicants submitted their documentation properly and within the established deadline except for the applicant with registration number 2601 who, by failing to submit documentation proving their legal personality according to the information provided in the initial application, is excluded from the contest in accordance with rule 10.

Thus, the Technical Commission decided to select another project, that of the applicant with registration number 2418, and asked its representative to provide proof of legal personality. This documentation was submitted properly and within the established deadline.

Therefore, given the above, once the projects have been evaluated and the accuracy of the data has been verified, the Technical Commission selects the following 10 projects as finalists of the Cultural Innovation International Prize, who will be submitted for consideration by the Prize Jury, in accordance with what is established in rule 10:
