

PROTOCOL FOR FILMING IN THE EXHIBITION GALLERIES OF THE CCCB

1. All filming in exhibition galleries containing original works must be supervised by the CCCB's Conservation staff.

2. The distance between spotlights and object will be kept between 2 and 3 metres.

3. The sum of the power of spotlights will be no more than 1200 watts.

4. Even respecting the minimum distance, a directional spotlight may not be left on the original work for more than 5 minutes.

5. The spotlights must be turned off if the surface temperature of the work increases appreciably or if the temperature of the room rises by 2°C.

6. All works filmed in the foreground must feature the credits of the lending institution in the final audiovisual product. The credits will be provided by the CCCB's Exhibitions Service.

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
